



Leeds Safety Evening Directions / Joining Instructions

29th October 2008 starting at 1845

Finding Leeds Airport

I am going to go out on a limb and assume that most of you can find Leeds unaided.

The venue is

Multiflight Café, South Side, Leeds Bradford International Airport,
Leeds, West Yorkshire [LS19 7UG](#)

The Airport is well signposted from all directions and major roads,

If you are coming from the North along the A658 (Harrogate Road) follow the signs for the airport but do not turn off the A658 at the small roundabout even though it is signposted airport, continue along the A658 (which now becomes Victoria Avenue) until you have gone through the underpass and turn left about 150 yards after you come out of it.

If you are coming from the Leeds direction on the A658 you will probably pass Murgatroyds Fish and Chip shop on the left at a set of traffic lights, this is about 300 yards before the right turn signposted Multiflight (the sign is on the right and easily missed).

If you end up at the terminal building you are in the wrong place and need to go back to the A658 and turn left at the roundabout and follow the directions as though coming from the North.

Driving through Leeds city centre is an experience to be avoided so a bit of map studying is worthwhile before you leave.

Car Parking

There should be ample parking at or near the Café, don't block the road by double parking it is an access road up to the hangars and is in constant use.

The Café

The Café is on the right as you drive up the access road toward Multiflight, it will probably be one of the few buildings with lights on at that time of night, if you get to the barrier you have gone too far.

Timings

Unfortunately due to a meeting earlier in the day we will only be on site from around 1700 that day and we need to get in and set up equipment, chairs etc. With this in mind we ask people to arrive for around 1830 and plan to start at around 1845. To give us chance to setup please try not to arrive before 1815, if you do you may be press ganged into moving chairs or ignored.

If you are not on time and find the external door closed or if you get lost don't worry as Gary's phone will be manned by Ian and he will come and let you in or find someone who can give you directions the number is **0777 563 1465**.
